

Oxford House Inc. - GRACE End of Year Report July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024

Oxford House Inc. (OHI) outreach staff and Regional Manager under the MO/GRACE contract opened six new Oxford Houses in the past year, providing 57 new beds for individuals in recovery. Missouri's entire network of houses is 51 Oxford Houses with 479 beds. These homes averaged an occupancy percentage of over 75% each month. Oxford House Kansas City members maintained an abstinence rate of 96% over the fiscal year.

New Oxford Houses were opened in Clay, Jackson, Green, and Jasper counties:

Oxford House Members:

Oxford House members are democratically voted in and accepted into each of the 51 homes in Missouri. In June 2024, 432 members surveyed a sample that showed 38.7% were still in aftercare and receiving services. During FY'24, Missouri Oxford House members averaged 401.1 days as members of a particular house, which is an incredible statistic!

Oxford House Meetings:

A bi-monthly State Association Meeting and monthly local Chapter meetings provide ongoing training on the Oxford House Model. Individual Oxford Houses have weekly business meetings, which review the Oxford House Model and focus on one tradition every week. As new houses are open, outreach staff will provide regular training and support for new officers. House and Chapter officer training was provided in each region, hosted by the Chapter, and taught by the outreach workers and seasoned members of houses.
